Achievements of 2015 - 2016 Priorities



Literacy

- 80% of all Elmdale students are at or above grade level in reading.
- 82% of students met their home reading goal.
- 85% students (K-4) participated in an Elmdale Summer Home Reading program.
- 22 students having difficulty completing home reading took part in a daily reading program with parent/ grandparent volunteers.
- 100% of students and 89% of families attended the Family Celebration of Reading, Writing and Art in February.



Numeracy

- Grade 3 and 4 teachers participated in Inquiry based workshops with HSD Learning Coaches focusing on numeracy.
- Focus on Guided Math in the classroom.



Wellness

- Over half of grade 3 and 4 students participated in the year round intramural program.
- Students learned about the importance of fresh fruit and vegetables in their lunches during nutrition month in March.
- Many students took the opportunity to use the gym for running activities before school on "cold" mornings throughout the year.



Technology

- Each teacher has been provided an iPad to use for student assessment and planning.
- Implemented an eNewsletter that provides extensive information highlighting monthly activities at Elmdale School.



Social Responsibility

- 7 families took advantage of Parenting Support Groups offered by the school's Social Worker. Students in these families received more Green Slips (positive behavior slips).
- 96% of Elmdale students have better than 85% attendance.
- Grade 2 & 3 classes participated in reading to a GrandPartner at Rest Haven.
