Uninterrupted Learning

Please contribute to uninterrupted learning for Elmdale students by ensuring your child is on time with a signed agenda book, lunch, lunch money, homework, books, skates and all other required school items. Please help your child by being organized so your child can focus on learning at school. Your child should be aware of pickup arrangements before coming to school to avoid unnecessary telephone calls. **Changes to routine pickup arrangements are discouraged, but when necessary should be** written in the agenda book. Inform the classroom teacher of any upcoming appointments via the agenda. Please respect dismissal times and only pick up your child early for urgent appointments. All Elmdale visitors and volunteers must report to the school office.

Cold Weather Recess Policy

We encourage students to dress warmly and go out for recesses because it is important to get some fresh air during the day. Remember germs, not cold air cause illness. Please consider keeping your child at home if he/she is



too ill to function at school. Our cold weather recess policy is to keep students inside at recess when the wind-chill factor is over -30. Noon hour recesses will be reduced to 15 minutes outside when wind-chills exceed -25.
