## **Reports from PAC Executives:**

- A motion was brought forward regarding setting guildlines for meeting attendance and sending regrets. - 16 Corporate letters were handed out, some by mail and others face to face. There
  have been a few replies back from the businesses, aslo a few new businesses were
  added. Joshelyn will take care of a spreadsheet to keep track of what's coming in.
- Cookie dough fundraiser is now complete and students have handed in there money and envelopes. A few members of the PAC committee will get together Tuesday October 25 at 1:00 to count the money and get the forms organized.

## **Unfinished Business for Decision and Action:**

- A subway lunch will be offered starting on Nov 24th. Subway will be offered the last Thursday of the month at a cost of \$3.75 per sub. Volunteers will be taking the students orders and money on those mornings as well there will be a volunteer to hand out the subs to the students at lunch time.
- PAC voted in favour of switching our pizza provider for pizza days. Starting November pizza will be ordered from Little Ceasar's instead of Niakwa Pizza. For the same price of \$2 the students will receive a little more pizza. Janet has volunteered to go speak with the owner of Niakwa and let him know of our decision.
- Laurena has volunteered to take a lead as a contact person in the Funscript fundraiser.
  PAC committee members compiled lists of there own favorite gift cards that they would
  like to see on the fundraiser. Laurena and Collin will get togther the week of Oct 29th to
  narrow down the list and set up the account with Funscript. The goal is to send letters
  home and start the fundraiser the week of Nov 7th and have all orders in by the end of
  November and have them back to the students middle of December in time for

Christmas.

#### **New Business for Referral:**
