Here’s how it will work. We will use a montage of still pictures and short video clips to promote how many different ways we can read at home, and how much fun it can be. **What we need from you is one still picture OR a 5 second video clip.** These will be uploaded by you directly to a private Dropbox account. If you send a video, please note that we will not be using the audio portion. The completed music videos will only be played at school and will be played during our Family Celebration of Learning event.

To upload your picture or video, you simply [click the link](#), and select the file to upload. Please be sure to fill out the first and last name on the upload form. These files are then transferred to the storage folder that is not accessible to anyone other than the administrator. Anyone can upload a file. You do NOT need a dropbox account to upload the file. The easiest way to capture and upload your file is by using your smartphone, but a computer can be used as well.

We look forward to putting this video together and anticipate the excitement that the children will have when they see themselves in the video.
